Halton Hills Public Library Launches Provocative New Lecture Series

The library will host monthly lectures featuring esteemed University of Guelph faculty members presenting on timely and thought-provoking topics.

The free lecture series kicks off on **December 13th at 7:30 pm in the John Elliott Theatre** with Dr. Ian Spears discussing “Why Conflict Resolution Fails?” and the reasons behind the seemingly endless wars we see occurring around the world. Upcoming 2018 lecture topics include:
